**ORDINANCE NO. 2231-2021**

**EXTENDING THE DEADLINE OF RENEWAL OF TRICYCLE PERMITS FROM THE ORIGINAL DEADLINE OF MARCH 31, 2021 IN THE CITY OF DAGUPAN.**

**WHEREAS**, this body is in receipt of a letter from His Honor, the City Mayor, requesting for a passage of an ordinance imposing moratorium on and/or extending the deadline of renewal of tricycle permits from the original deadline of March 31, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, Section 132 of Republic Act No 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code 1991 provides:

“Section 192. Local Taxing Authority – The power to impose a tax, fee, or charge or to generate revenue under this Code shall be exercised by the Sanggunian of the local government unit concerned through an appropriate emergency.”

**WHEREAS**, the enactment of said enabling ordinance will alleviate the economic hardship being felt by tricycle drivers and operators in our city amid the travel and passenger-capacity restriction imposed by the national government as part of health and safety protocols during the public health emergency;

**WHEREAS**, considering that there are more operators who have not yet renew their tricycle permits, it is but fitting and proper to give them consideration they, being one of the lifeblood of our city;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on joint motion of Councilors Michael B. Fernandez, Karlos Liberato E. Reyna IV, and Jose Netu M. Tamayo, duly and jointly seconded by Councilors Celia C. Lim and Marcelino D. Fernandez, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. PURPOSE. This ordinance aims to uplift the plight of business sector in view of the declared public health emergency.

Section 2. LIMITATION. The renewal of tricycle permits is extended to June 30, 2021.

Section 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision or portion of this Ordinance found to be violative to the Constitution or other existing laws shall not impair the provisions or parts thereof which shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
