

ORDINANCE NO. 2245-2022

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A 3- YEAR MORATORIUM ON PERMIT, REGULATORY, FRANCHISE AND OTHER FEES ON TRICYCLE OPERATION IMPOSED UNDER SECTIONS 239 AND 240, ARTICLE 38 (CHAPTER III), OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2089-2017 (REVISED REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF DAGUPAN) AND SECTION 9 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2130-2018 (REVISED COMPREHENSIVE TRICYCLE FRANCHISE ORDINANCE OF 2018 IN THE CITY OF DAGUPAN.).

WHEREAS, Sections 239 and 240, Article 38, of City Ordinance No. 2089-2017 provides for the permit fees on tricycle operations;

WHEREAS, the Covid-19 pandemic caused unprecedented disruption of economic activities and financial difficulties to the people of Dagupan;

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional government intervention to help our tricycle drivers and operators survive the spiraling and erratic fuel prices;

WHEREAS, Section 192 of the Local Government Code provides that local government units, through enactment of an ordinance, may grant tax exemptions, incentives, reliefs under such terms and conditions;

WHEREAS, relief from the above mentioned fees will help tricycle drivers and operators provide the needs of their family amidst the current fuel crisis vis a vis public transport sector hardships.

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint motion of Councilors Michael Fernandez and Karlos Liberato Reyna IV, duly and jointly seconded by Councilors Jose Netu M. Tamayo and Marcelino D. Fernandez, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Dagupan City in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A 3- YEAR MORATORIUM ON PERMIT, REGULATORY, FRANCHISE AND OTHER FEES ON TRICYCLE OPERATION IMPOSED UNDER SECTIONS 239 AND 240, ARTICLE 38 (CHAPTER III), OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2089-2017 AND SECTION 9 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2130-2018.**”

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. This Ordinance imposes moratorium on permit, regulatory, franchise and other fees on tricycle operation provided under Article 38, Sections 239 and 240 of City Ordinance No. 2089-2017 (Revenue Code of Dagupan) and Section 9 of City Ordinance No. 2130-2018 (Revised Comprehensive Tricycle Franchise Ordinance of 2018 in the City of Dagupan) for the period provided in this Ordinance.

The issuance by the City Government of permits, licenses, stickers, IDs, clearances, and grant of franchises to qualified Tricycle Operators shall not be interrupted by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. MORATORIUM PERIOD. The permit, regulatory, franchise and other fees under Sections 239 and 240 of City Ordinance No. 2089-2017 and Section 9 of the City Ordinance No. 2130-2018 shall not be imposed from the first day of 2023 until the last day of 2025.

Additionally, the requirement of payment for identification cards to our tricycle drivers shall not be collected but shall be provided for by the City Government of Dagupan.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATION OF LEAD OFFICES. The Office of the City Treasurer, the One- Stop Business Center, and Public Order and Safety Office (POSO) are hereby designated as the lead departments in facilitating the effective and efficient implementation of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal or unconstitutional, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any previously issued ordinance, or provision of ordinance, which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication.
