





ORDINANCE NO. 2251-2022

PRESCRIBING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES ON: OPERATION OF FISHING BOATS AND OPERATON OF MOTORIZED BANCAS AND BOATS FOR PASSENGER, MERCHANDISE, CARGO FERRYING AND OTHER PURPOSES, THEREBY AMENDING FOR THIS PURPOSE SECTION 56 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1768-2003, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE DAGUPAN CITY COASTAL FISHERIES RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE OF 2003.

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Article XIII of the Philippine Constitution provides that "the state shall protect the rights of subsistence fishermen, especially of local communities, to the preferential use of the communal marine and fishing resources, both inland and offshore. It shall provide support to such fishermen through appropriate technology and research, adequate financial, production, and marketing assistance, and other services. The State shall also protect, develop, and conserve such resources. The protection shall extend to offshore fishing grounds of subsistence fishermen against foreign intrusion. Fish workers shall receive a just share from their labor in the utilization of marine and fishing resources;"

WHEREAS, the City Government of Dagupan has enacted Ordinance No. 1768-2003 or the Dagupan City Coastal Fisheries Resource Management Ordinance of 2003 which aims to provide sustainable management, development and conservation of all Dagupan City and coastal fishery resources;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City Government of Dagupan to provide an effective measure for a systematic, balanced, adequate and disciplined public transportation system both in land and water;


WHEREAS, keeping the Schedule of General Fees during its pre-pandemic levels, specifically under the previous reduced rates adopted in Ordinance No. 2048-2015 and making it permanent, augurs well for the economic upliftment of our fishermen and their dependent families who have long been overburdened with the heavy costs;


Section 2. **REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, rules and regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that the rights that are vested upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.


Section 3. **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


