ORDINANCE NO. 2266-2023

ESTABLISHING AND ADOPTING THE "BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION CENTER (BSRC)" IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF DAGUPAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD REGULATION NO. 2, SERIES OF 2018 AS ENHANCED BY DANGEROUS DRUGS BOARD REGULATION NO. 3, SERIES OF 2022.

WHEREAS, Section 77 of Republic Act No. 9165 otherwise known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, as amended (RA 9165)" provides that the Dangerous Drugs Board (the "Board") to be the policy-making and strategy formulating body in the field of drug prevention and control;

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 2, Series of 2018 provides that the implementation of the Balay Silangan program be endorsed to the level of local government units in support of the anti-illegal drugs advocacy of the government;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2022 provides for the establishment of Balay Silangan Reformation Center to cater qualified pushers and plea bargainers;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Dagupan has appropriated Anti-Drug Abuse funds and assigned facilities therefor for the implementation of the aforementioned Board Regulations in order to conduct supply reduction initiatives, civic awareness and demand reduction, classify drug personalities, situational analysis;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Michael B. Fernandez, duly and jointly seconded by Councilors Jeslito C. Seen, Dennis C. Canto, and Marcelino D. Fernandez, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in its regular session assembled that:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION PROGRAM (BSRP) IN STAC-BUILDING, CITY SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE COMPOUND, BRGY. POBLACION OESTE, DAGUPAN CITY. The BSRP shall be operational in the former STAC building located at City Social Welfare and Development Office Compound, Brgy. Poblacion Oeste, Dagupan City in order to implement such program providing for the necessary Lecture Rooms, Counselling Room, Sleeping Quarters, Comfort Rooms, Mess Area/Pantry, Clinic, and Sports/Recreational Area, among others.

SECTION 2. BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION PROGRAM (BSRP) COMPONENT. The pushers and plea bargainers enrolled in the BSRP shall undergo three (3) months reformation program which include one (1) month mandatory in-house for Education, Health, Psychosocial and Physical Activities and two (2) months Livelihood or Employment Education phase.

Only those reformists who completed the one (1) month mandatory in-house certified by the case manager shall proceed to:

A. Education and Health

- Knowledge on Illegal Drugs;
- Ill-effects of Illegal Drugs; and
- Lecture on RA 9165, as amended by RA 10640

B. Psychosocial and Physical Activities

- Counseling Sessions;
- Consultative Sessions;
- Moral Recovery Activities;
- Discipline and Values Formation;
- Personal and Life Skills; and
- Exercises and Sports Activities

C. Livelihood or Employment Education to be included but not limited to the following:

- Gardening
- Soap Making



- Massage Training or Reflexology
- Basic Carpentry
- Basic Welding and Electrical
- Basic Haircutting
- Food Processing

D. After-Care Services

- Continuous Counselling;
- Job Placement; and
- Alternative Economic Development Program

SECTION 3. QUALIFICATIONS OF PUSHER AND PLEA BARGAINERS TO BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION PROGRAM (BSRP).

- Listed in PDEA-PNP Certified BADAC Watch List (PDEA-PNP-CBWL) (except for offenders who served sentence or acquitted by the court).
- Pushers who surrendered but not listed in the PDEA-PNP Certified BADAC Watch List shall undergo validation process. The said pusher shall be qualified in BSRP once listed upon conduct of management of watch list.
- Surrenderers who are not High Value Target.
- Plea-Bargainers with court order for admission to BSRP.
- Referral from other Government Agencies

SECTION 4. ADMISSION.

A. Submission of Documents

- Endorsement Letter from BADAC Chairman
- Affidavit of Undertaking from the Police Station
- Court Order for admission to BSRC, if applicable

B. Assessment

- Medical and Physical Examination
- Psychological Test, if available
- Profiling
- Drug Test
- Other laboratory tests as may be deemed necessary (e.g COVID-19 RT-PCR Test, Chest X-Ray, and the like)

C. Program Orientation

SECTION 5. MONITORING AND REPORTING

ADAC focal person shall submit periodic report to PDEA Regional Office.

SECTION 6. COMPLETION OF THE BALAY SILANGAN REFORMATION PROGRAM (BSRP). The Facility Head shall issue a Certificate of Completion of the BSRP to Reformists who are considered graduates after having completed the Education, Health, Psychosocial, Physical Activities, Livelihood, and/or Employment Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED,** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to establish and adopt the "Balay Silangan Refomation Center" in the City Government of Dagupan in accordance with Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 2, Series of 2018 as enhanced by Dangerous Drugs Regulation No. 3, Series of 2022.


